Opener: What do you like best about parades: Bands? Famous personalities? Celebrating the occasion? Vendors? Clowns?

Go Deeper:

Zechariah 9:9-13; 16-17

- 1. What qualities will Zion's King possess?
- 2. Describe the scene at the coming of the King. How will the people respond?
- 3. Why the donkey (v. 9; see Matthew 21:5 for Jesus use of it), instead of the war-horse (v. 10)?
- 4. On what basis will restoration be given to prisoners or exiles?

John 12:12-19

- 5. Using your imagination, what might the crowds, the disciples, and Jewish leaders be feeling as the scene unfolds before them?
- 6. Compare those feelings to one week later, Easter morning.
- 7. If you had been present for Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, what might you have felt: fanaticism, fickleness, faith, or fear? Why?



- 8. All four Gospels record the procession into Jerusalem. Compare and contrast them with John's version: Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-10; Luke 20:29-40.
- 9. Kingship is an important theme in John (see 1:49; 6:14-15), and the nature of power is redefined by Jesus, how?
