

The 5% Life: Go Time February 18 & 19, 2023 Acts 1:1-11 | 2 Corinthians 5:17-21

Opener: If you were appointed as an ambassador for the United States, where would you like to be sent?

Go Deeper:

- 1. What does Paul mean by what he says about Christ and our response to him (vv. 15-17; see also Romans 6:5-13)?
- 2. If we aren't reformed, rehabilitated, or re-educated, what are we? (cf. Colossians 2:6, 7) When we live in Christ, we are not merely turning over a new leaf; we are beginning a new life under a new Master.
- 3. What does "reconciliation" mean? What story from your life illustrates this?
- 4. What does God do through Christ (v. 18)? Through us (v. 20)? For us (vv. 17-18)?
- 5. What motivates you to share your faith? If you rarely do so, what inhibits you?
- 6. How can you grow in your awe of God and love for Christ this week?
- 7. Knowing what it is like to be alienated and reconciled in other relationships, how is it going with God: Still a family feud, a truce, or have you made up?

Go Deeper:



- 8. In what ways has God changed your life?
- 9. Tell of ways your walk with Christ has influenced how you relate to a) yourself; b) family; c) neighbors; d) the world.
- 10. Tell of a time you were excited or moved to share your love of Christ.

Application:

- 1. What new thing are you sensing God wants to do in and through you today?
- 2. Are there any places or people you think God may be sending you to with the Gospel message?
- 3. What concerns do you have about how the particulars of the assignment get accomplished?
