

Close Encounters #3: Wrestling With God September 23 & 24, 2023 Genesis 32:22-30

Opener: Have you ever wrestled with someone? Who was it? Why did you wrestle with that person? Who won?

Go Deeper:

- 1. What is the significance of Jacob being left alone by the Jabbok River in verse 24? Why was this a pivotal moment in his life?
- 2. What might the physical and emotional struggle that Jacob has as he wrestles with the "man" in the text symbolize in a broader sense?
- 3. Why was Jacob so determined to receive a blessing, and what does this reveal about his character at this point in his life journey?
- 4. What does the name change from "Jacob" to "Israel" signify, and how does it relate to the themes of transformation and identity in the passage?

Live It:

- 1. Have you ever experienced a "night of doubt" or a challenging period in your life where you felt alone and uncertain? How did you handle it, and did you seek God's guidance during that time?
- 2. Jacob received a new name and identity after his encounter with God. How can you relate to the idea of being transformed by God and receiving a new identity as a child of God?
- 3. What blessings or guidance are you currently seeking from God, and how can you persevere in seeking His blessings with faith and prayer?
- 4. What specifically is God saying to you?
- 5. What specifically are you going to do about it this week?
