

The Ultimate Question #7: What Will You Do With Jesus?

March 30 & 31, 2024 John 11: 1-3, 6, 20-27, 43-44

Opener:

Share a personal experience where you felt your life was in mortal danger.

Go Deeper:

- 1. Have you ever felt like you were drowning in life, desperately needing someone to save you? How does this analogy resonate with your understanding of salvation?
- 2. Read Romans 3:23. How does this verse present the concept of sin and challenge the idea of human goodness? How does it shape your perspective on salvation?
- 3. Reflect on your own experiences or observations regarding people's beliefs about their goodness and their perceived ability to save themselves. How does this relate to the Biblical truth that salvation comes through faith in Jesus alone?
- 4. Consider Martha's response to Jesus in John 11:20-22. Have you ever found yourself questioning God's timing or methods in difficult situations? How does this resonate with your own faith journey?
- 5. Reflect on your own expectations of how Jesus should intervene in your life. How do these expectations align with Martha's initial response to Jesus in John 11?
- 6. Consider the significance of Jesus' resurrection. How does Jesus' victory over death solidify His identity and authority as the only Savior?

Live It:

- 1. How can you incorporate a deeper understanding of your need for salvation into your daily prayers and reflections?
- 2. In what practical ways can you relinquish the idea of self-salvation and fully trust in Jesus for your eternal life?
- 3. Reflect on a recent situation where you struggled with your expectations of how Jesus should intervene. How can you surrender those expectations and trust in Jesus' sovereignty?
- 4. How can you cultivate a deeper sense of Jesus being the resurrection and the life in your daily life and interactions with others?
- 5. What is God saying to you?
- 6. What specifically are you going to do about it this week?
