- 4. 1 Corinthians 15:51-53: How does Paul describe the transformation that will occur at the resurrection? What does this reveal about what life will be like after the resurrection?
- 5. 1 Corinthians 15:54-55: What is the significance of death being "swallowed up in victory," and how does this relate to the promise of salvation by faith in Jesus Christ?

Live It:


- 1. Would you be a Christian if there was no resurrection?

- 4. What is God saying to you specifically?
- 5. What step of faith is God calling you to live in this coming week?
