- 4. How does 1 Timothy 2:5-6 elaborate on the concept of Jesus being a mediator and ransom for all?
- 5. Read Galatians 4:4-7. How does this passage describe our adoption as sons and daughters of God?
- 6. How does Romans 8:14-17 describe the benefits and responsibilities of being part of God's family?

Live It:

- 1. How can you daily remind yourself of the significance of Jesus' sacrifice for your sins?
- 2. How does knowing that Jesus paid a ransom for your life change the way you view your worth and purpose?
- 3. How can you keep your focus on the eternal inheritance promised to you in Christ amidst daily challenges?
- 4. What is God saying to you specifically?
- 5. What step of faith is God calling you to live in this coming week?
