



Confirmation Code of Conduct

Whether you are a member of Victory Lutheran Church or a guest, our Confirmation Code of Conduct is based on the expectation that all youth and adults will conduct themselves in a Christian manner during all classroom and youth activities. The following is a statement of conduct to be read and agreed to by your signature as a student and your parent(s) are also to read and verify that you understand these policies of conduct and they will also sign this document.

Electronic Devices: Use of Electronics is a privilege, not a right, and will only be allowed under certain conditions. If use of devices (phones, i-devices, tablets, computers, etc.) gets in the way of relationships, the spirit of the class, it is entirely within the rights of the teacher to confiscate the device for any amount of time deemed appropriate, including the duration of the event. The device may be returned to the parents after the event with a conference (consisting of the Youth leader, parent[s], and youth).

Respect of People: Youth must respect, listen to, and cooperate with all adult Leaders as well as fellow youth. Bullying, harassment, and intimidation will not be tolerated. Negative talk, put downs, and disrespect are not allowed. Harassment, intimidation or bullying can take many forms including: slurs, rumors, jokes, innuendo's, demeaning comments, drawing

cartoons, pranks, gestures, physical attacks, threats, social media posts, or other written, oral or physical actions.

Respect of Property: Youth will respect the facility where the activity takes place, others' property and their own. Students that are involved in the act of breaking something will be expected to repair/replace the damaged item(s) at his/her expense. Any form of stealing or using others property without their approval or knowledge will not be tolerated.

Safety: Once you are on campus, you will follow the instructions of the teacher and not leave campus until picked up by a legal guardian. Youth will follow all instructions given to them by the teachers to ensure their own safety and protection. Drugs, alcohol, firearms or weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.

Participation: We expect our youth to come to class on time and ready to learn. We will not accept behavior that interferes with the full participation of others' education or growth. Students are expected to participate willingly in the planned activities. You are here to develop and explore a growing relationship with Christ. There will be times that are fun and crazy, and times that are structured learning environments.

Character: We believe in the Christian standard of being loving toward the neighbor and expect our youth to avoid profanity, put-downs, stealing, arguing, exhibiting improper behavior, using alcohol or illegal substances, possession of unauthorized drugs, possession of weapons, and dishonesty. We expect our youth to speak in a kind manner and to work out differences in a peaceful

and non-violent manner, involving teachers or other adults whenever help is needed.
