



Timeless Call #4: Promise in the Passover

September 28 & 29, 2024

Exodus 12:1-3, 5-8, 11-14 & Hebrews 9:11-22

Opener:

What is your favorite family meal or tradition, and why is it special to you?

Go Deeper:

1. In Exodus 12:1-8, why was the Passover lamb required to be without blemish, and what does this detail signify about the nature of sacrifice?
 2. In Hebrews 9:11-14, how does Jesus, as our High Priest, offer a superior sacrifice compared to the Old Testament sacrifices? What makes His offering "once for all"?
 3. Luke 22:19-20 records Jesus reinterpreting the Passover meal. How do His words about the bread and the cup reflect both the continuity and fulfillment of God's salvation plan?
 4. In what ways does the concept of the Passover in the Old Testament foreshadow Christ's ultimate sacrifice for humanity? How does this deepen your understanding of both events?

Live It:

1. Communion is more than a ritual; it's a connection to God's timeless plan. How can you approach communion differently to experience it with deeper significance?
2. Just as the Israelites trusted in the blood of the Passover lamb for deliverance, we are called to trust in the blood of Christ. How does this trust influence the way you deal with guilt, shame, or fear in your daily life?
3. Reflecting on how God's deliverance is both physical and spiritual, what area of your life are you seeking God's freedom in today? How can you open yourself to His work in that area?
4. God's plan of redemption was not just for the Israelites but for all humanity. Is there someone in your family or friendship group that you could pray about how to share the good news of salvation through faith in Jesus Christ? As a group, pray for those people.
