Luke 3:21-22

Opener:

When and where were you baptized?

Go Deeper:

- 1. What details stand out to you in Jesus' baptism?
- 2. How do you see each member of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) involved, and why is this significant?
- 3. The Father's voice from heaven proclaims, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." How does this statement affirm both Jesus' identity and mission?
- 4. How does understanding Jesus' true identity (Son of God, Messiah) deepen your appreciation for His humility in being baptized?

Live It:

- 1. In Lutheran teaching, we emphasize that baptism is primarily God's action, not something we do for Him. How does this teaching free us from fear and legalism?
- 2. How does knowing that your baptism is a once-for-all event, based on Christ's perfect work, shape your view of God's grace?
- 3. Consider how being baptized into Christ means being named as God's beloved child. How does this reality challenge any feelings of isolation or insecurity you might have?
- 4. What aspects of God's fatherly love and acceptance bring you the most comfort?
