

# Revealing the Messiah #3: Messianic Mic-Drop January 18 & 19, 2025

Luke 4:14-20

### Opener:

Think of a time in your life when you received news that completely lifted a heavy burden that you were carrying.

#### Go Deeper:

- 1. Luke 4:18-19 comes from Isaiah 58:6 and 61:1-2. Read those passages in Isaiah and the surrounding verses in Isaiah 61. Why do you think Jesus read those exact verses? What did He NOT include?
- 2. From what bondage or captivity does Jesus release the captives? Read Matthew 23:2-4,13-15; John 8:34-36; Hebrews 2:14-15.
- 3. How does Isaiah 61 describe the "year of the Lord's favor"?
- 4. This is Jesus' "Mission Statement" and marked the first time He stated His purpose. What does it mean for something to be "fulfilled in your hearing?"

#### Live It:

- 1. What areas of your life have you faced bondage? Talk about what it would mean to free people and yourself from the bondage of religion, sin, death, and the devil.
- 2. Jesus' announcement of freedom isn't a one-time event but a lifetime of freedom. How would your life be different if you lived this freedom every day?
- 3. As a captive set free, in what ways can you now deliver this same message to your neighbor?
- 4. How can you live your life "freed to serve?" See Galatians 5:13-14.
