

Revealing the Messiah #7: "Bringing God Your Big Questions" February 15 & 16, 2025

Luke 7:18-35

Opener:

Can you name a time you were absolutely certain about something — only to realize you were totally wrong?

Go Deeper:

- 1. Why do you think John, who was once so confident about Jesus, is now doubting Him?
- 2. How do Jesus' actions beyond just His words reveal who He really is?
- 3. What do you make of the difference between John's importance and the status we have through Christ's kingdom?
- 4. How can our personal preferences or strict expectations prevent us from truly recognizing Jesus?

Live It:

- 1. Can you recall a time when your own ideas about God kept you from noticing what He was doing in your life?
- 2. Think about a situation either now or in the past where you questioned God. What would it look like to honestly bring those questions to Him in prayer, trusting He can handle your doubts?
- 3. Jesus says that even the "least" person in His kingdom is greater than the greatest prophet. How does that change the way you see your own worth or purpose?
- 4. Are there any parts of your life where you've tried to force Jesus into the way you think He "should" work or show up?
