Go Deeper:


1. What do you think heaven will be like?

 3. Jesus talked about His Father's house having many rooms. We often think of heaven as a future hope, but in what ways is belonging to God's household something we can experience here and now?
 4. Read Romans 8:18 and 1 Corinthians 2:9. How do Paul's words about future glory encourage you when current challenges feel overwhelming?
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Live It:

1. What does being "children of God" (John 1:12; 1 John 3:1) change about the way you see yourself?
2. Do you have a small group, Bible study, or trusted circle of Christian friends? If not, what steps can you take to find or start one this month?
3. If you are already in a small group, how can you be more intentional about "having each other's back," especially when crises hit?
4. Think about your home, your social circles, or even your row at church. Is there room—physically, emotionally, spiritually—for someone new? Who could you invite to coffee, a meal, or a church service to make them feel welcome?
