Go Deeper:


- 1. What do you think heaven will be like?

- 4. Read Romans 8:18 and 1 Corinthians 2:9. How do Paul's words about future glory encourage you when current challenges feel overwhelming?

- 1. What does being "children of God" (John 1:12; 1 John 3:1) change about the way you see yourself?
- 2. Do you have a small group, Bible study, or trusted circle of Christian friends? If not, what steps can you take to find or start one this month?
- 3. If you are already in a small group, how can you be more intentional about "having each other's back," especially when crises hit?
- 4. Think about your home, your social circles, or even your row at church. Is there room—physically, emotionally, spiritually—for someone new? Who could you invite to coffee, a meal, or a church service to make them feel welcome?
