Opener:

Go Deeper:


- 1. Read Acts 2:1-4. What stands out to you about how the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost?
- 2. Why do you think God chose wind and fire as symbols of the Spirit?
- 3. How would you describe the disciples before and after Pentecost?
- 4. Read Galatians 4:6-7. What difference does it make in your life to know you're not just forgiven, but adopted?

Live It:

- 1. Where in your life do you feel like your spiritual fire is burning bright?
- 2. Where do you feel like it's flickering or fading?
- 3. Read Luke 11:11-13. Jesus compares the Father to an earthly parent—how does that reshape how you think about prayer?
- 4. Read 1 Peter 1:3-5. What words in this passage describe our inheritance?
- 5. Have you ever had a time when Scripture or godly friends helped clarify what you thought God might be saying?
- 6. Who in your life might need to hear that they are not forgotten, that they are loved and chosen?
