Go Deeper:

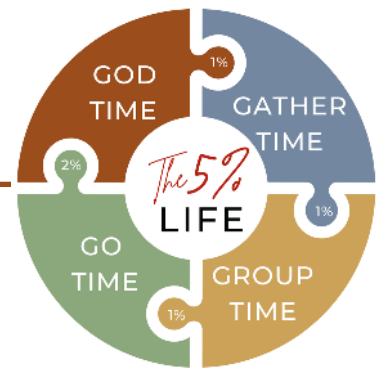
1. Read Acts 2:1-4. What stands out to you about how the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost?
2. Why do you think God chose wind and fire as symbols of the Spirit?
3. How would you describe the disciples before and after Pentecost?
4. Read Galatians 4:6-7. What difference does it make in your life to know you're not just forgiven, but adopted?

Live It:

1. Where in your life do you feel like your spiritual fire is burning bright?
2. Where do you feel like it's flickering or fading?
3. Read Luke 11:11-13. Jesus compares the Father to an earthly parent—how does that reshape how you think about prayer?
4. Read 1 Peter 1:3-5. What words in this passage describe our inheritance?
5. Have you ever had a time when Scripture or godly friends helped clarify what you thought God might be saying?
6. Who in your life might need to hear that they are not forgotten, that they are loved and chosen?
