Opener:

Go Deeper:

- 1. Read Exodus 2:21–22. What does the name Gershom reveal about Moses' emotional and spiritual state?
- 2. Read Exodus 3:1. What do you notice about the setting where God chooses to speak? Why might that be important?
- 3. Read Acts 7:29–30. How does this passage from Stephen's speech help interpret Moses' time in the desert?
- 4. Read Deuteronomy 32:10–12. List the verbs that describe what God does for His people in the desert. What do these actions say about God's heart?
- 5. Read Hebrews 4:15–16. How does Jesus identify with us in our desert experiences?


Live It:

Apply the message personally and practically.

- 1. What desert are you walking through right now—emotionally, physically, relationally, or spiritually?
- 2. How might God be using solitude, obscurity, time, or discomfort to shape you in this season?
- 3. What have you been clinging to that God might be asking you to release, so you can listen more closely?
- 4. What is one practical way you can "take God's hand" this week—through prayer, Scripture, or community?
- 5. Who in your life might need to hear this truth today? How can you be a voice of hope?
