

God's Will, God's Way #4: "Failing Forward" July 5 & 6, 2025

Exodus 2:11-25

Opener:

Share a time when you took a wrong turn while driving or got lost, but it led to discovering something unexpectedly good. How did that "mistake" turn out to be a blessing?

Go Deeper:

Explore the biblical text and reflect on its meaning.

- 1. What details in Exodus 2:15b-22 suggest God was orchestrating Moses' circumstances rather than Moses just running away?
- 2. Compare Moses' responses in Exodus 2:17 and 2:11-12. What similarities show God's consistent work in Moses' heart?
- 3. Moses names his son "Gershom" meaning "a foreigner in a foreign land." How does God use seasons of feeling like "foreigners" to prepare His people?
- 4. How do Peter's words in 1 Peter 5:6-10 about humbling ourselves connect to Moses' experience? What does this teach about God's timing?

Live It:

Apply the message personally and practically.

- 1. What current roles might God be using to prepare you for future opportunities? How can you see them as "training ground" rather than mundane tasks?
- 2. Share about a time you felt in a season of delay or detour. How do you maintain faith during wilderness seasons?
- 3. Think of a past failure. How might God want to redeem that experience for His glory and your growth?
- 4. What current situation requires you to trust God's providence without seeing the bigger picture? How can we pray for you?
