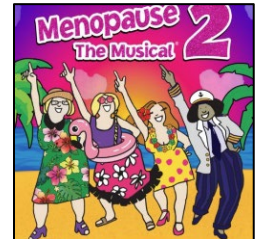
Menopause The Musical 2: Cruising Through The Change (Off Site – Bus)

Sign up and pay \$42 (ticket and bus) by Sunday October 12.

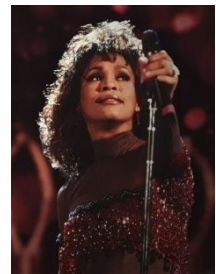


The Voice of Whitney – A Symphonic Celebration (Off Site – Bus)
