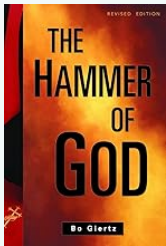
Love to read books? The Book Club meets monthly on the 4th Tuesday from 1:30-3:00pm. Please come prepared to discuss the monthly book selection.

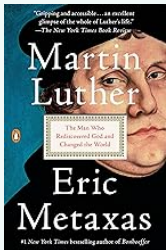


"The Hammer of God: Revised Edition" by Bo Giertz

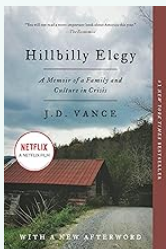

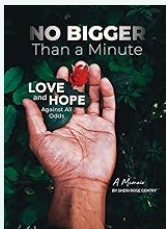

A passionate and personal analysis of a culture in crisis—that of white working-class Americans—and the inside story of how upward mobility really feels.

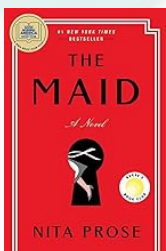
