GOD TIME: Serving as Worship
Pastor Todd Mathison

There's a moment near the end of King David's life that always humbles me. He gathers God's people to bring their resources for the building of the Temple—an act of worship so overflowing that it moves David to pray: ***"Everything comes from You, and we have given You only what comes from Your hand"*** (1 Chronicles 29:14). That's the heartbeat of a steward. A steward sees everything differently.

Steward: it's not a word we use often, but biblically, it's central to understanding our lives and purpose.

A steward is someone who manages what belongs to someone else. That's us. Everything we carry—our time, abilities, energy, passions, days—comes from God's hand and ultimately returns to His glory.

And here's the surprise: generosity isn't about losing anything. It's about returning what already came from God. When we see life through the eyes of a steward, something shifts. Giving becomes joy, not pressure. David didn't say, *"We have to give."* He said, *"We get to give."* Stewardship stops feeling like paying God back and starts feeling like joining Him in His work.

Right now at Victory, our Ministry Fair is a living picture of that truth—tables covered with opportunities to worship God by serving His people: worship, care, missions, children, hospitality, tech, outreach, Bible studies. Each one is a stone of faithfulness...an invitation from God Himself.

So take a moment. Walk slowly. Pray before you choose. Ask the Lord, "What's my next step serving in Your Kingdom?" And when He nudges—step into it. Make it happen.

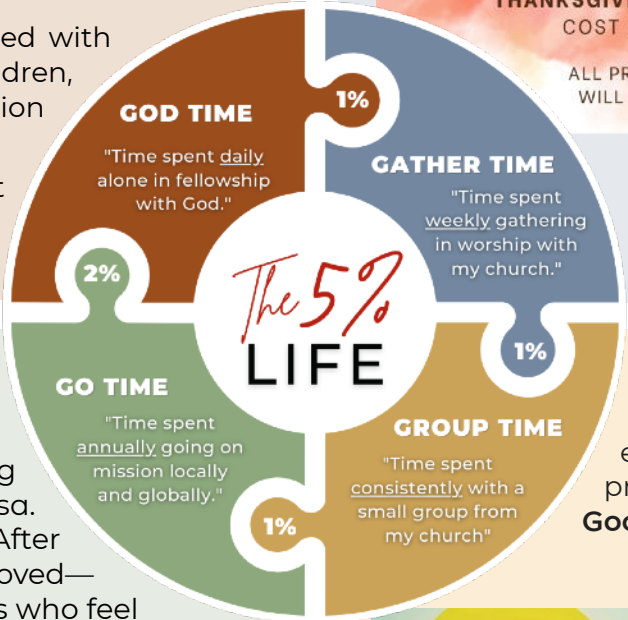


Dear Victory Family,
