Go Deeper: *(Exploring the Bible)*

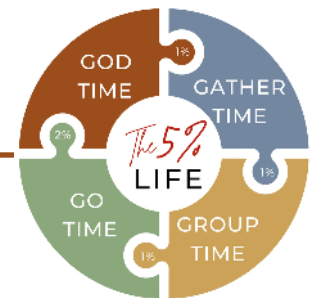
1. In Luke 24:13–16, what do these opening verses show us about the emotional and spiritual condition of the two disciples?

 4. In Luke 24:35, why does the phrase “known to them in the breaking of the bread” matter so much for the life of the Church?

2. What does this Bible text encourage you to do when your heart feels heavy and your faith feels weak?
3. How can staying near God's Word and the gathered life of the Church help reframe the way you face this week?
4. Who around you may need the hope-filled reminder that the risen Jesus still comes near to weary people?
